DeAnn Compton provided an update on the current audit process, which is already under way for this year's report. The objectives are the same as they have been in the past. She noted bi-weekly conference calls have been set up between her office and Longwood and cooperation has been strong. He gave an overview of audit activities since the previous Board meeting, including hot line calls and scheduled audit activities, as well as a consulting project for the Andy Taylor Center for Early Childhood Education. President Reveley commended the work of the office in assisting this new enterprise within the university.
